# **GROS MORNE SUMMER MUSIC FESTIVAL RETURNS TO NORRIS POINT**

This summer, Saturday evenings will again bring music and musicians from around the world – classical, jazz, world, folk, opera and traditional Newfoundland music in an atmosphere that is chatty, welcoming and warm! Now in its eighth year!, Gros Morne Summer Music has seen increases in performance attendance and in the number of gifted musicians who have visited and shared their talents in this historic park for the first time.

Commendation and support of its Artistic Director, David Maggs, has been offered by the *Royal Conservatory of Music*, in Toronto, (from which David is a graduate) and from its President, Dr. Peter Simon.

The weekly concerts at Good Shepherd run on **Saturday evenings, from July 24<sup>th</sup> through August 21<sup>st</sup> beginning at 8 pm**.

Below are details for each week's scheduled performance and the musicians that will be involved.

### SATURDAY, JULY 24<sup>th</sup>

**"What a wonderful mixed up world!"**

Week 1 reveals just how interconnected our modern world is. Cultures, ethnic identities, musical styles - everything is topsy-turvy; nothing is in its place, and hey, it all sounds great! Long time fixture of the Corner Brook scene, Clarinetist **Karem Simon** is back to join Gros Morne Summer Music (GMSM) artists-in-residence **David Maggs and Diederick van Dijk** in music for clarinet, piano and cello.

The second half of the program stars Indian and world-beats percussionist **Curtis Andrews** from the east coast of Newfoundland, and his friend, **Kurai Mubaiwa** all the way from Africa in a feast of music from all over the world!
