Bonne Bay Cottage Hospital

The Bonne Bay Cottage Hospital Heritage Corporation has received a six week extension to the JCP Project. The project, which employs seven workers, will now terminate on May 31, 2006. The main goal of this project is to re-establish the Bonne Bay Cottage Hospital as a functioning community building. It is hoped that, by the early summer, the old hospital will house the public library and some low cost accommodations. It is also hoped that the facility will provide space for commercial rental and community activities.

The corporation and the Town Council would like to commend the workers for the outstanding job they have been doing in restoring the old hospital. Their efforts are greatly appreciated.



Roaming Dogs

The Town of Norris Point has dog regulations stating that it is illegal for animals to roam freely.

The dog catcher is currently checking the area for roaming animals. If your animal is caught, it will cost \$50.00 to get the animal back before it leaves the town. If taken out of the town, additional charges will have to be paid.

Storm Drains

It should be noted that it is illegal to have weeping tile and drain pipes leading into the town sewer system.

This system is not designed to handle the increased amount of water. Overloading the system may cause flooding in low areas.
