

# Roaming Dogs

Section 4 (1) of the Provincial Dog Act states: every owner of a dog shall keep it safely tied, tethered or penned at all times.

All dog owners are urged to keep their dogs on their own property. If your dog is found to be roaming freely within the Town and onto another person's property, you could be charged in a court of law.

The Town does have an animal control officer and your dog could be impounded if caught roaming and you would have to pay a fee to have your dog returned.

## Garbage Collection

It is Council's Policy that all garbage must be placed in a garbage box or at the curbside on garbage day for pickup by the maintenance workers. Please note that in winter your garbage box must be shovelled out for access.

Also it is the homeowner's responsibility to protect their garbage, when at the curbside, from crows, animals and other pest.

## Town Plan

The Town Consultants have been working on the New Town Plan for Norris Point for a few months now and it will soon be completed. Once it is completed it can be viewed at the Town office during regular office hours.
