The property owner gave an update on the history of the property and private road that boarders their property. Council feels this is a private issue and we are unable to resolve this.

Shoreline Property in Wild Cove – a letter was received inquiring about a fishing shed located in Wild Cove. The shed is located on Crown Lands property but the ownership of the building is unclear. The shed is in our system as a Government owned property. As per the Municipalities Act the Town is unable to charge any property taxes to Government Properties.

Come Home Year Committee – A letter was received from the committee expressing their disappointment in why the Recreation committee was invited to the Council Christmas social but their committee was not.
