## Boil Water Advisory

Town Maintenance workers will be flushing our system starting Monday, May 6-10. You may notice some discoloration in your water and/or low water pressure. As a result of this flushing, the entire Town will be placed on a PRECAUTIONARY BOIL ORDER until further notice.

A flyer will be mailed notifying you once the order has been lifted.

We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.

### WRWM

There will be NO bulk curb side collection during Town Cleanup for 2019.

Due to the closure of our old dumpsite town workers would be required to transport these items to the new transfer site at a cost of \$164/tonne.

Instead WRWM is offering four Saturdays in June designated for FREE "residential" drop off only. This does not apply to any commercial businesses.

WRWM announced that there is a discounted rate of \$60/tonne for sorted shingles.

## Illegal Dumping

## Tax Deadline

June 30, 2019

Unfortunately, after this deadline, any overdue accounts will have their services discontinued and further action will be taken to collect any outstanding arrears. **There will be no exceptions to this deadline.**

## General Repair Permits

*No person shall carry out any development within the Planning Area unless a permit for development has been issued by the Town of Norris Point.*

Failure to obtain a general repairs permit will result in a fine. The cost of the permit and a fine (equivalent to the original permit cost) will be billed to the residents account.

## Animal Control

An Animal Control officer will continue to conduct monthly visits to our Town looking for animals not tethered or penned. Fee for release of impounded animal - \$50.00.
