



Curbside Spring CLEANUP May 11 & 12

Town employees will be collecting items on the scheduled days only; NO construction, demolition, or trees/shrubs will be accepted. Maintenance staff will use their discretion and will only collect items that are approved within the categories listed below.

May 11 - BULK WASTE ONLY

Acceptable Items: Furniture, bathroom fixtures, toys, carpets, large bulky items that are not accepted with regular garbage collection.
(Smaller loose items can be placed in CLEAR plastic bags)

May 12 - SCRAP METALS & ELECTRONICS ONLY

Acceptable Items: steel, cast iron, aluminum, etc. ie. fridges, stoves, washers, dryers, barbeques, computers, tv's, printers, etc.

Any items not included in this list will need to be dropped off at the Long Range Waste Transfer Site.

Household hazardous: Paint cans, oils, batteries, etc (FREE)
Construction & Demolition: Shingles, wood, trees (FEES APPLY)

IMPORTANT: Western Regional Waste Management offers a \$25 credit to each household with a card in good standing (credit expires on Dec 31/22). If you do not have a card - visit the local waste site beforehand to obtain one. ID is required.
