Boil Water Advisory

You will be notified once the order has been lifted.

Residential Bulk Cleanup

Town employees will be collecting items on the scheduled days only;

May 11- Bulk Waste Only

Acceptable items include; Furniture, bathroom fixtures, toys, carpets, large bulky items that are not accepted with regular garbage collection.

(Smaller loose items can be place in CLEAR plastic bags)

May 12- Scrap Metals & Electronics ONLY

Acceptable items include; Steel, Cast iron, aluminum, etc. ie. Fridges, stoves, washers, dryers, bbq's, computers, tv, printers, etc

NO CONSTRUCTION, DEMOLITION or TREES & SHRUBS will be Accepted!!

June 30, 2021

No person shall carry out any development within the Planning Area unless a permit for development has been issued by the Town of Norris Point.

Town Projects

The second is a non motorized trail and this will begin across from the Dump Road area and lead right to the end of Neddies Harbour Road.
